 - Some will be difficult to strike or claw-back (CRA look-back)

Health & Safety Priorities




- ✓ PRIORITIZE Work Zone Safety

- Less than a dozen state DOTs require binder solvent extraction
- QA labs will need to identify/control exposure and implement Chemical Hygiene Plan
- ✓ Manage Vehicle Fleet / Transportation Risk
